## **Update on Hosting**

1. STBP Hosting Consultants presented updates for the Executive Committee.

## **Stop TB Partnership Governance**

- The Executive Director explained the current global situation in line with holding virtual versus in-person
  meetings, including risks of travel and travel bans; concluding that it would be prudent to plan the next
  Board Meeting to be virtual. The option of a mixed modality was also considered by the Executive
  Committee. The Executive Committee finally decided to support the Secretariat with plans for a virtual mode
  Board Meeting.
- 3. The Chair cautioned the Executive Committee to examine, going forward, to what extent it is compatible to have a country as co-host in a virtual meeting. In addition to discussing in depth the intentions to have side-events. The Secretariat responded that some possible side-events could be planned to focus around G20 (India, Indonesia) and the topic will come back to the Executive Committee to be discussed in another call.
- 4. The Secretariat presented which Board members are ending their terms of office. Board representatives ending a two-term period (cannot serve another term):
  - a. Developing Country NGO\*
  - b. Developed Country NGO\*
  - c. TB-Affected Communities\*
  - d. Brazil
  - e. India
  - f. Mozambique
  - g. Research Working Groups\*

Board representatives ending one term of office:

- a. Kazakhstan
- b. Nigeria
- c. Private Sector\*



- 5. The Executive Committee discussed and agreed on the extension of two Board members, Kazakhstan and Nigeria. Constituencies (marked with \*) will run their own selection processes and inform the Secretariat of the new Board member which will finally be endorsed by the Board.
- 6. The Secretariat proposed for the Executive Committee's consideration:
  - a) replacing India with Indonesia,
  - b) replacing Mozambique with either Democratic Republic of Congo or Zambia, and
  - c) Brazil with another country from Latin America, possibly Peru.
  - The Executive Committee agreed to invite Indonesia to become a Board member and approach the Democratic Republic of Congo to offer a seat on the Board. The third seat for a country affected by TB (replacement of Brazil) will be discussed in the next call.
- 7. The Board representative of Developing Country NGO updated the Executive Committee on the delegation's timeline to elect a new Board member by June 2021.
- 8. The Board representative of the Research Working Groups updated the Executive Committee on its constituency's plans for the seat on the Board.

### 9. Action items:

- The Secretariat to initiate planning for a virtual Board Meeting.
- The Secretariat to prepare official correspondence to invite Indonesia and the Democratic Republic of Congo to become new Board members.
- The Secretariat to follow-up with various constituencies for updates on their selection processes for new Board members.
