TARGETING TB CONTROL IN AFRICA

African Governments and health policy makers will:

- Include TB in development agenda and poverty reduction plans
- Strengthen DOTS services and address health system problems
- Expand collaborative TB/HIV activities
- Establish national Stop TB partnerships

Donor agencies, NGOs and technical agencies will:

- Renew and increase sufficient funding for TB control
- Improve coordination among partners in countries
- Integrate TB control into HIV/AIDS services

Stop TB Partnership will:

- Launch a regional Stop TB Partnership for Africa
- Organize an African TB financing summit
- Hold Stop TB Partners' Forum in Africa in 2007
