- > @StopTB wants change this #worldtbday. Read our statement here.
- Still 3.3 million people not reached with TB services. What's wrong with the way we fight #TB? #ReachTreatCureEveryone
- > We need radically new ways to reach and treat people affected by TB.
- Nearly 2 billion people are estimated to have latent TB infection that is one person in three worldwide! #worldtbday
- About 1.5 million people die from #TB each year -- this equates to 4000 people/day. We have to end this. #worldtbday
- BRICS countries are home to half the world's cases of TB. On #worldtbday, let's call on BRICS leaders to make TB a health priority.
- > Bedaquiline and Delamanid are two new drugs that are saving lives of MDR-TB pateints. #worldtbday
- We need increased funding for TB research and we need it now! Any delay now will cost us much more in the future. #worldtbday
- > This #worldtbday Invest in interventions tailored to the economic, geographic and social landscape.
- If AIDS could be cured in 6 months, would a third of those living with HIV be ignored? Why accept this for TB? #ReachTreatCureEveryone
- StopTB message this #worldtbday Reach the 3 million. Reach. Treat. Cure Everyone.

- > Leave no one behind this #worldtbday. Access to #TB care is a right. #ReachTreatCureEveryone
- Out of the 9 million new #TB cases 2013, 3.3 million are consistently missed by health systems. It's just not right!
- 3.3 million people with #TB are missed because they were not diagnosed or because they were diagnosed but not reported. #WTBD2015

- There is an urgent need to fill the current funding gap of USD 2 billion per year for TB interventions #worldtbday

3. General tweets/messages on tuberculosis

- ▶ Not so fun fact: In 2013, 9 million people fell ill with #TB and 1.5 million died #worldtbday
- > Not so fun fact: #TB is among the top 3 causes of death for women aged 15-44. #worldtbday

- * #TB is second only to #HIV/AIDS as the greatest infectious killer worldwide. We can help stop that!
 #worldtbday
- > #TB is a leading killer of people living with #HIV causing one quarter of all HIV-related deaths. #worldtbday
- Drug-resistant #TB is present in virtually all countries surveyed. >480,000 people developed drug-resistant TB in 2013. #worldtbday
- > Did you know? In 2013, about 80% of reported #TB cases occurred in 22 countries. #worldtbday
- Only 97,000 patients were started on drug-resistant TB treatment last year. Less than one in 5 who need it! #worldtbday
- In 2013, 5.5 million people enrolled in HIV care were screened for TB, up from 4.1 million in 2012.

- 480,000 people developed drug-resistant #TB in 2013. > Half of these cases were in #India, #China and #Russia. #worldtbday
- > Up to 80,000 children died due to #TB globally in 2013 no more childhood #TB! #worldtbday
- > Did you know? No country has eliminated #TB it is a problem for all of us! #worldtbday
- Number of new #TB cases drops less than 2% a year. At that rate it will take >200 yrs to end TB.
- Not so fun fact: 10% of all drug-resistant cases are resistant to all almost all #TB drugs. We need new effective drugs! #worldtbday
- Did you know? The Copenhagen Consensus economists rank #TB control the 4th most cost-effective investment for a better future! #worldtbday

- > #TBREACH supports partners to provide quality care to those who cannot access it #WorldTBDay
- Did you know? #TBREACH incubates local innovations in TB care delivery that are not funded anywhere. #WorldTBDay
- ▶ #TBREACH encourages bold, local solutions that may not be funded elsewhere #WorldTBDay
- Fact! In 2014, TB REACH funded 143 partners in 48 countries. #WorldTBDay
- In the fourth wave of funding by #TBREACH, 33 projects were selected backed by \$13.9m USD in 2014 #WorldTBDay
- > 1.4 million patients have been treated with support from #TBREACH across 48 countries. #worldtbday

- In 2014, #TBREACH/GDF platform procured 125 GeneXpert machines and supported programs using over 700,000 cartridges. #worldtbday
- #TBREACH supports local organizations & prioritizes finding people with TB among vulnerable population.

- #TBREACH services are valuable for children, mining affected communities, migrants, indigenous & incarcerated populations & ethnic minorities
- In the last five years, #TBREACH has supported 143 projects in 48 countries through 4 rounds of funding worth USD 76.5 million with support fm Canada!
- > On average, #TBREACH projects show a 33% increase in TB patients treated in project areas. #WorldTBDay

- #GDF has supported 134 countries since 2001 increasing access to quality-assured TB treatments. Many more to come! #WorldTBDay
- So far #GDF delivered 26 million 1st line drugs (FLDs) treating 24.5 million adult patients & 1.3 million paediatric patients
- Did you know? #GDF has delivered 2nd line drugs for 152,494 drug resistant TB patients #WorldTBDay
- #GDF has massively contributed to active case-finding: delivered diagnostics worth of US \$ 82 million #WorldTBDay
- Fact! #GDF reduced the price of some major 2nd line drugs by more than 30% in 2014 #WorldTBDay
- #GDF has contributed to a healthier market with improved security supply of TB commodities #WorldTBDay
- Did you know? #GDF delivered 25% 1st line drugs for all notified cases in the public sector in 2013 #WorldTBDay
- Fact! #GDF delivered 33% 2nd line drugs for MDR-TB cases notified on treatment in 2013 #WorldTBDay
- > #GDF delivered 51% of paediatric drugs of all notified cases in 2013 #WorldTBDay
- Since 2001, #GDF has processed orders for TB products with a value of approximately US \$1.2 billion #WorldTBDay
