

# The Global Plan to Stop TB 2016 – 2020 Work Plan and Budget

## **Background**

Since its creation in 2001, the Stop TB Partnership has issued five and ten-year global plans to provide a road map for concerted global action, and to provide an estimate for the resources needed to achieve the goals the world has set.

#### **Work Plan**

The development of the Global Plan is envisaged to take 18 months from its Board initial go-ahead, at the end of January 2014.

The work is envisaged in seven phases: preparatory work; modelling/costing/country outreach; drafting; community and stakeholder consultations; global reach through; web-based comments; Board endorsement; and launch.

Modelling/costing/ country outreach	Agree on country groupings/clustering and modelling and costing assumptions; development of interventions packages for each region; assessing new technology that will become available before 2020; beginning new tools drafting process; conduct country interviews; execute modelling exercise; write up findings	Aug-Nov 2014
Drafting	Agree on structure for the Plan and write first draft	Oct-Dec 2014
Community and stakeholder consultations	Hold regional consultations (if possible linked to other events); conduct two additional regional consultations by phone conference Hold two global stakeholder (civil society, communities) consultations.	Jan-Apr 2015
Web-based consultations and finalization of draft	Set up and moderate a web-based discussion on the Global Plan; encourage input from all stakeholders; finalize the Plan text.	May-Aug 2015

The work plan envisages that the Task Force meets through phone conferences on the average once every six weeks, with more frequent interactions at key periods. A meeting in person will be needed at the beginning of September, at the end of the initial drafting process (January 2015) and again at the end of the consultation process, before the final drafting (June or July 2015).
