




Inclusiveness index

- The index for inclusiveness ranged from 44% to 90%.
- Zambia and Zimbabwe) achieved an index of 50% or more in inclusiveness.
- Of these 20, the countries that achieved a score of more than 75% were Mozambique (75%), Indonesia (79%), South Africa (82%) and India (90%).



Note - A score of 20 corresponds to 100%.
