

Xpert price reductions: overview

- Price reduction of the Xpert MTB/RIF Ultra cartridge from \$9.98 to \$7.97
- Price reduction of the Xpert MTB/XDR cartridge from \$19.80 to \$14.90
- Pricing is valid as of September 18, 2023
 - Global Fund framework agreement of 2 years, with option to be extended
- 20 million Xpert MTB/RIF Ultra cartridges were procured globally in 2022: with the new price, \$40 million of savings could be used to buy ~5 million more tests annually
- Country example: Funding envelope of \$8 million for Xpert MTB/RIF Ultra

Previous price: \$8 million / (\$9.98 + \$1 for shipping/fees) = 728,000 cartridges New price: \$8 million / (\$7.97 + \$1 for shipping/fees) = 891,000 cartridges



Xpert price reductions: who is eligible?

- Pricing is applicable for the Global Fund, Stop TB Partnership, USAID, and all buyers meeting the eligibility criteria of the Cepheid Global Access Program
- Available to all countries supported by the Global Fund

- Eligible countries can also use domestic funds to buy cartridges directly from Cepheid at the lower prices
 - Use must be to meet public health needs; cartridges must be provided free of cost
 - For ordering directly from Cepheid, payment must be made upfront in US dollars
 - If national regulations preclude this, discuss procurement options with the GF
 Wambo or Stop TB GDF to access the lower prices



Changes in service and maintenance options

- Outcome of negotiations between Cepheid and the Global Fund, Stop TB and USAID:
 Cepheid has committed to offer comprehensive service and maintenance packages in the form of AccessCare or Warranty+
- AccessCare and Warranty+ include:
 - replacement modules and parts and XpertCheck kits (as covered by standard warranties)
 - on-site visits of an authorised service provider for module swaps, instrument repair, installations and preventative maintenance
- Difference is the ordering/costing modality
 - AccessCare: cartridge surcharge (bundling) across all cartridges bought by a Ministry of Health, including for TB, HIV, HCV, HPV, etc
 - Warranty+: annually per instrument




Changes in service and maintenance options

- AccessCare and Warranty+ are both executed under a Service Level Agreement (SLA)
 - Standard KPIs and targets on service provider performance, instrument/module uptime
 - Monthly KPI reports shared with countries
- All GF-supported countries will be offered AccessCare or Warranty+
 - Small number of exceptions, e.g., embargoed countries
- Costs:
 - AccessCare: three tiers according to average module utilisation in a country, i.e., average number of tests performed per module per year
 - \$0.90, \$1.20 and \$1.50
 - Warranty+: \$3,790 per year for a GX4; \$3,500 per year under a 3-year contract

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Transitioning from 6-color to 10-color modules

- Instruments with 10-color modules are required to run the Xpert MTB/XDR tests
- Bundle offer:
 - 4-module 10-color instrument system at the price of a 4-module 6-color (\$17,500)
 plus 50 Xpert MTB/XDR tests free of charge
 - Available until end of 2023
- Hybrid instruments that run 6-color and 10-color modules: Cepheid is developing a GeneXpert software update to make this possible
 - Expected to be available in the first half of 2024
 - Desktops/laptops will need to be of a certain version to accept the software update
 - For instruments that are under AccessCare or Warranty+, refurbished 10-color modules will be provided when 6-color modules require replacement at the time of XpertCheck or other failure
