## Agenda for consultation meeting between Federal Ministry of Health National TB and Leprosy Control Programme, WHO and TB partners Thursday and Friday, May 5-6, 2005 Federal Ministry of Health, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia

**Background:** TB is a major public health problem in Ethiopia, which is one of the 22 high TB burden countries. The TB and Leprosy Diseases Prevention and Control Team (TLCT) in the Federal Ministry of Health coordinates the national efforts to control the TB epidemic in collaboration with Regional Health Bureaus, WHO and other partners. TLCT planned to conduct a half-day consultation with the TB Department of WHO and other interested partners in conjunction with the upcoming meeting of the Coordinating Board of the Stop TB Partnership, which will be held in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia in the period May 3-4, 2005. The planned consultation meeting will be held on May 5, 2005 in the premises of the Federal Ministry of Health of Ethiopia.

**Objectives:** The meeting will have the following objectives

- 1. To review the overall performance of the National TB control activities in Ethiopia and identify outstanding challenges and constraints to achieve the TB control targets.
- 2. To strengthen and renew the commitment and support from WHO and other technical and donor agencies to TB control activities in Ethiopia.
- 3. The NTP to be provided directions and suggestions how to scale-up TB/HIV activities, initiate External Quality Assessment of TB labs, strengthen community DOTS and address the potential threat of MDR-TB.
