Introduction

At the Addis Ababa meeting (3-4 May 2005), the Stop TB Partnership Coordinating Board adopted the Blue Print for TB Control in Africa (2005-2007). Since that time significant progress has been made towards fulfilling the obligations and demands of the Blueprint. A considerable amount of work remains to be done. Attached is a Progress Report that outlines upcoming challenges.

Summary

There will be four parts to the Africa TB Emergency session:

- 1. An Update on Progress since Addis Ababa and Next Steps.
- 2. Status and needs of TB control programme in D R Congo, Nigeria and Kenya.
- 3. A presentation on the role of the Church in TB Control in Africa. The Catholic Church provides a significant proportion of healthcare in Africa. The Board will learn of opportunities to work with the Church to take forward the TB control agenda.
- 4. A discussion on the possible upcoming Heads of State meeting scheduled for April 2006 in Abuja Nigeria with a representative of the Ministry of Health of Nigeria.

Decisions requested from the Stop TB Coordinating Board

- o Confirm choice of Abuja for Coordinating Board meeting in April 2006.
- Endorse a back-to-back approach for the Coordinating Board, Health and Finance Ministers and Heads of State meeting.
- o Comment on and facilitate steps to support needs outlined by country representatives.
