Ninoy Aquino International Airport (Naia) and Transportation Options

Arrival Entry Card / eTravel Registration

- All arriving international passengers are required to complete the eTravel Registration via this link to the official site: https://etravel.gov.ph
- Please note that the QR code generated after completing this registration is mandatory for entry into the country.
- Registration must be completed within 72 hours prior to your scheduled arrival.
- If not completed in advance, the form may still be filled out upon arrival at NAIA.

NAIA to The Westin Manila

Transport Options

- The Westin Manila –Arrange an airport transfer (sedan, ₱2,800/approx. USD 48), by emailing westinmanila@westin.com in advance. Driver details will be sent 2–3 hours before your arrival.
- **Grab** similar to Uber; book via the **Grab app** and meet drivers at designated airport pickup points. Offers cashless payment and fixed fares.
- Airport Taxis Yellow-metered taxis offer fixed rates and are also readily available.

Hotel Location

- Corner of San Miguel Avenue & Lourdes Drive, Ortigas Business District, Mandaluyong City
- ~10 km (15–30 minutes depending on traffic) from NAIA

Suggestions & Safety Tips

- Avoid unofficial taxis
- Keep small bills handy for taxis, as drivers may have limited change.
- Allow extra travel time during peak hours (7–10 AM, 5–8 PM).
